



Site regulations “B Camping”, Bissel

Hello dear camping guest!

Welcome to our campsite. We look forward to your visit and wish you a relaxing stay.

We will do our best to make your stay here a pleasant one. To ensure your stay runs smoothly, we ask you to consider the following points. You can make a significant contribution.

1. Generally

The campsite rules are legally binding upon entry to the campsite and must be adhered to. They are publicly displayed at the reception, on the display board, and available on the website.

These campsite rules apply to all visitors and guests, whether on pitches or in rental accommodation.

1. Access to the campsite is only permitted after proper online booking or registration of each person/pet. Each guest and visitor pays the applicable rates for this campsite.
2. Smoking is prohibited in all buildings and rental properties. Please smoke only outside and as long as it doesn't disturb anyone.
3. The campsite staff is authorized to give instructions regarding parking regulations, safety, hygiene and compliance with the campsite rules.

2. Emergencies

Please always inform the campsite staff after making the emergency call or call us on the phone (0151-20 44 58 67), and we will direct the vehicle to you! **You can find the emergency number at the information desk, and you can also reach us using the number in your booking confirmation.**

3. Arrival/Departure

1. Arrival is possible from 1 p.m. We look forward to a "Hello" in any case.
The access road is a fire department access and may not be blocked at any time.
2. Departure should be by 11 a.m. We look forward to a "goodbye."
3. Leave your accommodation/pitch clean and tidy.
4. For rental units: Please make sure to bring your personal belongings with you. Dishes must be washed, dried, and placed in the designated cupboard, and trash must be removed from the rental unit. See also the "Waste/Trash Disposal" section.
5. Arrival and departure can only take place within the rental period.

4. Noise and quiet times

1. Please be considerate of other camping guests and avoid disturbing noise. In particular, smartphones, radios, and televisions should be used in a manner that does not disturb your neighbors. Any loudspeakers or music boxes found to be inappropriate may be confiscated immediately and until your departure.
2. Noisy work, such as operating gardening equipment, is prohibited during rest periods.
3. Please observe the following quiet times: **12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m.** (midday quiet) and **11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** (night quiet). During the quiet hours, all loudspeakers must be turned off completely, and conversations must be conducted at tent volume (whispering).
If noise bothers you, please address the guests directly and politely. If the disruptive behavior persists, please call us at +49 151 20 44 58 67. We are available day and night and will address the issue immediately on site.
4. For registered events at "B Camping", the start of the night's rest can be postponed to midnight.

5. Vehicle traffic is prohibited during rest periods.

5. Vehicles (traffic regulations)

1. The campsite is a pedestrian zone. For safety reasons, driving is only permitted at walking pace. Children, pedestrians, and cyclists always have priority.
2. Parking is strictly prohibited on all paths within the campsite.
3. During the night rest period, it is not permitted to drive any type of vehicle onto the campsite.
4. One registered car/two motorcycles and/or one motorhome is permitted per pitch. Additional cars/trailers may park in an area designated by "B Camping."
5. The campsite may grant exceptions for additional pitches. Parking vehicles on unused pitches, as well as parking unregistered vehicles, is prohibited. A fee of €5.00 per day will be charged.
6. Cars and motorcycles must be parked next to the tent or caravan so that they do not obstruct traffic or neighbors. All roads and paths on the site must be kept clear for emergency vehicles at all times, day and night.
7. In winter conditions, there is no guarantee that the site will be accessible by foot or by car.

6. Children / Teenagers

Consideration for others: Children should be able to let off steam. However, some consideration for other guests and careful handling of the facilities and equipment are still required. Unnecessary noise, littering, and damage are to be avoided. Please explain to your children and teens the relevant aspects of the site rules.

1. Children are allowed to play throughout the entire area, including on the paths. Supervisors must be present around the ponds.
2. Children and young people up to the age of 16 may camp with us only if accompanied by a parent, teacher, or other adult. Young people up to the age of 18 require written permission from their legal guardian.
3. A playground with a caravan is available for children. Parents are responsible for supervising their children at all times. If they fail to do so, they are liable for any damage caused by their children.
4. Alcohol and smoking are prohibited on the playground.

7. Visitors

1. The campsite may only be entered by registered persons.
2. The persons named in the contract (guests) are registered. Additional visitors are subject to our visitor policy.
3. The guest must register his visitors before arrival and is responsible for paying the visitor fees and for compliance with the general terms and conditions and campsite regulations. If visitors are not registered, we reserve the right to charge a visitor fee of €60.
4. Visitors' cars are parked in visitor parking spaces. "B Camping" may grant exceptions to other parking spaces for a fee.

8. Pets

1. The bringing of dogs and cats (hereinafter referred to as "pets") requires prior notification by the guest; permission for other animals must be requested from the campsite, specifying the exact species. In all cases, the campsite reserves the right to refuse permission at any time and without giving reasons.
2. An additional fee must be paid for each pet brought along, the amount of which will be communicated to the guest by the campsite when the pet is advertised/booked.
3. Dogs are not permitted in beds or on upholstered furniture in our rental accommodations. If hair is found, a special cleaning service will be arranged for a fee. Please bring your own suitable bedding.
4. Dogs must be kept on a leash throughout the entire property. Leashes may only be removed in secure, enclosed personal areas.
5. Dogs may only be kept on solidly fenced premises during their owners' absence. Tethering dogs is prohibited in accordance with Section 7 of the Animal Welfare Dog Ordinance. Owners are obliged to ensure that the duration of their absence does not compromise the appropriate care of their animals.
6. Pets are not allowed in the sanitary buildings or on other people's pitches (un-/rented).
7. Any damage or contamination caused by pets must be removed immediately by the pet owner.
8. Dog excrement must be disposed of immediately in the residual waste using a bag.

9. Failure to dispose of dog waste may result in expulsion or other sanctions.
10. Dog owners must have dog liability insurance for their dogs.
11. Aggressive dogs are prohibited to protect guests and staff (for us, this includes any dog that suddenly snaps or is aggressive).
12. The validity of the Lower Saxony Law on Keeping Dogs (NHundG) in its currently valid version is expressly pointed out.

9. Pitches

Construction

A well-designed pitch layout makes the campsite attractive and safe. We are an environmentally friendly campsite and strive to minimize human impact on the environment while showcasing the beauty of nature. We strive to preserve the forest character of the campsite.

1. The caravans, awnings and tents may only be set up in such a way that they can be moved at any time (e.g. in case of fire) and can also be removed quickly by emergency services.
2. A safety distance of at least 3 metres must be maintained between caravans, motorhomes, tents and rental properties.
3. Any digging requires permission from the campsite management. Damaged turf is subject to compensation.
4. Make sure that no one is endangered by tent pegs/pegs/other anchors (max. 30 cm deep), tent ropes, or other camping equipment. Mark hard-to-see hazards with clearly visible markers, such as ribbons/flags.
5. Trees may not be removed, trimmed, or otherwise damaged (no nails may be driven in, no antennas may be attached, no ropes or tent ties may be attached).
6. Planting is only permitted within the scope of the planting plan and must be agreed upon in advance with "B Camping." Allotment gardening is not permitted. Driveways from the clearing to the permanent campsite are not to be planted. Planting bushes and trees must be agreed upon in advance with "B Camping."
7. If there are hedges or trees on your pitch (annual and seasonal pitch), you are responsible for their maintenance. This includes pruning any branches that extend too far beyond the plot. The hedge must not exceed 2.00 m in height. It is prohibited to trim or cut back hedges, living fences, bushes, and other woody plants between March 1 and September 30; gentle shaping and maintenance pruning to remove overgrowth or to maintain the health of trees is permitted (according to Section 39 of the Federal Nature Conservation Act of March 1, 2010).
8. Therefore, no permanent extensions, modifications, substructures, etc. may be built in, on or around the caravan or the awning on the pitches.
9. Non-permanent buildings (e.g. tool sheds) must not exceed 6m² in size.
10. Mobile fences for dogs and small children up to a maximum height of 1.2 m are permitted.

Power supply

1. You will be supplied with green electricity (for a fee).
2. Only operators and their personnel are permitted to open the power distribution boxes.
3. Guests are responsible for their own electrical connection from the point of use. Only intact CEE extension cables with CEE plugs/couplings may be used.
4. Cable drums must always be unwound completely.
5. There is no legal right to electricity supply. Electricity can only be provided if a connection is available.
6. Operating balcony power plants that feed into the campsite's grid is prohibited. This can also cause damage and outages to the power grid. Only so-called "standalone" systems, which must have their own storage, are permitted. Please contact us before installation.
7. The campsite reserves the right to manually read electricity based on consumption. Electricity may be used for air conditioning and heating if billed by the kWh. Please contact us before use. This is not possible at every pitch. Unreported excessive consumption will be billed at a flat rate in addition to the booking.
8. Charging electric vehicles is prohibited. Failure to comply will result in a charge based on the battery capacity shown on the vehicle registration document per night. Furthermore, a €1,000 damage deposit is required, which will be retained for 24 months. This will be used to cover any damage to the power grid after charging.

Gas

1. For safety reasons, gas cylinders must not weigh more than 11 kg.
2. A maximum of 2 bottles are permitted per pitch.

3. Gas systems and camping heaters must comply with legal regulations and the guidelines of DVGW worksheet G 607 and must be serviced at least every two years.

Drinking water

1. On our campsite, water taps are generally only intended for drinking water.
2. Water is a precious commodity, so we ask you to use it sparingly and not to use it unnecessarily, for example, to water the lawn.
3. The water at the taps is turned off when it freezes to protect the pipes.

Order and cleanliness

1. Order, cleanliness, and mutual consideration are the natural responsibilities of all campsite users. You certainly value cleanliness just as much as we do. Therefore, we ask you to keep the grounds, especially the restrooms, clean and tidy so that guests who arrive after you can use them safely. Please instruct your children to follow this rule.
2. The staff has the right to ask you to remove any rubbish or other items lying around your accommodation.
3. We would like to point out that long-term guests are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their parking space. If the space does not meet the requirements, you will receive verbal notification. In this case, we ask you to tidy up immediately, otherwise a fee of 100 euros will be charged.
4. Washing vehicles is not permitted on the campsite.
5. When leaving your caravan or rental unit, always lock it and lock the windows.

10. Sanitary facilities

Our campsite has a biological wastewater treatment plant installed to operate independently of the public sewer system while simultaneously protecting the natural environment. This presents some challenges. By disposing of waste properly, you can actively contribute to environmental protection.

Wastewater/toilet disposal

1. Wastewater cassettes/black water may not be discharged onto the ground or through floor inlets, nor may they be allowed to seep into the ground. The resulting wastewater must be collected in suitable, covered containers and emptied only into the designated sinks in the sanitary building. A violation will result in a minimum fine of €500.
2. Only natural and biodegradable products are permitted for disposal via wastewater, as biocides such as "Aqua Kem Blue" harm the biological wastewater treatment plant. A violation will result in a minimum fine of €500.
3. **No matter which route, the following do not belong in the wastewater:**
Items such as cleaning wipes, menstrual hygiene products, wet wipes, tissues, kitchen paper, etc., food scraps, oils and grease, chemicals, medications, cigarettes, and other waste must be disposed of in the appropriate trash cans.

A violation costs at least 500€.

Any disregard leads to inconvenience for everyone, the environment and additional costs, and in the medium term to **higher prices.**

Sanitary facilities

1. The restrooms and common areas are cleaned several times a day. If cleaning is required outside of these hours, please contact the staff.
2. Small children should only use public restrooms when accompanied by an adult.
3. Animals, cigarettes, glass bottles, glasses and other dangerous objects are prohibited in this area.
4. Please do not wash dishes or laundry in the restrooms.
5. The washer and dryer provided must be treated with care. In case of any malfunctions, please notify the staff.
6. Showering is only permitted for our guests.

11. Shelter hut

At our campsite, you'll find a shelter hut opposite the ponds. This was built to provide shelter in bad weather (storms), especially for cyclists or tent guests. However, it is also available to all guests for parties and gatherings. For a fun-filled get-together and to protect the environment, we ask you to observe the following points.

1. If you celebrate, you can also clean up.
2. The use of disposable tableware is prohibited for environmental reasons.
3. Open fires are prohibited in the hut.

12. Nature and environmental protection

1. We, too, are increasingly taking ecological and environmental concerns into account and invite you to support us in our efforts. Unnecessary consumption can be reduced in many ways: when showering, washing dishes, using detergent and electricity, and, last but not least, by avoiding and properly sorting waste. Your efforts help us keep costs low. You also make a valuable contribution to the health and preservation of our environment!
2. Feeding wild animals is prohibited.
3. Cutting down or damaging trees, branches, twigs, bushes and plants is not permitted.

13. Use of the ponds

Our two ponds serve to enhance the beauty of our grounds and provide a place for relaxation. In order to protect nature and ensure your safety, the following rules apply:

1. Swimming is strictly prohibited! Bathing and swimming in the ponds is strictly prohibited. The ponds are not official swimming areas. There is no lifeguard on duty, and the ground conditions and underwater plants can pose hazards. Use of the shore areas is at your own risk. Parents are responsible for their children.
2. Entering the shore vegetation and removing plants is not permitted. Animals (ducks, fish, etc.) must not be fed. Food scraps and bread significantly impair water quality and promote algae growth.
3. Children may only approach the ponds when accompanied by an adult.
4. Entering the ice in winter is life-threatening and strictly prohibited.

14. Garbage and disposal

1. Everyone is personally responsible for the removal and disposal of their own waste. Please always use garbage bags, as these prevent contamination and, especially in summer, unpleasant odors.
2. Our waste management policy is based on ecological principles and waste prevention. You'll find our bins at the restroom building.

Please note our waste separation policy:

- Black bin = household waste only (residual waste)
- Yellow bin = Green Dot, packaging waste
- Blue bin = paper, cardboard, cartons (disassembled)
- Glass container = event meadow

3. Only household waste that was generated during your stay at the campsite may be disposed of.
4. The dumping and disposal of bulky waste, electronic waste, scrap metal, chemicals, charcoal, wood scrap, rechargeable batteries, camping chairs, tables, umbrellas, gazebos, awnings, or similar items is prohibited! **Please contact us** to find out about your options.

5. Green waste and similar waste from permanently used parking spaces must be separated:
 - Foliage: special place
 - Grass cuttings and flowers etc. green waste container
 - Branches and hedges

Please feel free to contact us about this topic.

15. Barbecue/ fire

Please ensure that the surface remains undamaged. You may be liable for damages. Barbecues must be supervised at all times. Please be considerate of your neighbors and their camping equipment regarding flying sparks, odors, and smoke.

1. Barbecues are permitted on your pitch with:
 - Gas grill always.
 - Electric grill up to a maximum of 1,000 watts (otherwise cable damage)
 - Charcoal grill up to forest fire level 3, with special safety measures (wet floor, bucket of water next to it, extinguish embers completely, never leave unattended).
Only dry coal may be used here. Burning other materials is not permitted.
From level 4 onwards, charcoal grilling is prohibited! Smoke development must be avoided. Residues may only be disposed of the following day in the designated bin once they have completely cooled down, and not on the premises or anywhere else.
2. Open fire pits, fire bowls and campfires are permitted on your pitch:
 - Up to forest fire level 3, with special safety measures (wet ground, bucket of water nearby, completely extinguish embers, never leave unattended). Only dry wood may be used here. Burning other materials is not permitted. Open fires are prohibited from level 4 upwards! Smoke development must be avoided. Residues may only be disposed of the following day in the designated bin once they have completely cooled down, not on the grounds or anywhere else.

16. Fire protection

1. Fire extinguishers are available for firefighting at clearly marked locations on the campsite. Fire extinguishers may only be used to extinguish fires. The use of fire extinguishers must be reported to campsite staff afterward.
2. If fire extinguishers are deliberately used for other purposes, any resulting damage (personal injury and property damage) must be borne by the person responsible.
3. This also applies to the costs of restoring the functionality of fire extinguishers that have been used intentionally.
4. If a fire breaks out, the fire brigade must be alerted immediately by calling the emergency number 112 and the campsite management or their staff must be informed.
5. Fireworks are prohibited on the campsite. We refrain from using fireworks to protect nature and wildlife, to reduce waste, and to ensure safety and well-being.

17. Business

The campsite is reserved for recreational use. The conduct of any business on or from the campsite, as well as exhibitions on the site, require the approval of the campsite management.

18. Weapons

1. The use, carrying or storage of firearms, blank-firing and gas weapons, cutting and stabbing weapons as well as pyrotechnic/chemical materials are prohibited on the entire campsite.
2. Dangerous items are confiscated and handed over to the police for safekeeping.

19. Drones/ Film & Photo Work

1. The use of drones (unmanned aerial systems and model aircraft with or without cameras) is prohibited on or above the campsite. The only exception is for film and photo shoots carried out or supervised by the campsite management.

20. WLAN/Wi -Fi

Use is free for guests.

The terms of use for guest Wi-Fi

1. Subject and scope of these Terms of Use

These terms of use govern your and our rights and obligations in connection with the use of our guest Wi-Fi access.

2. Our services

(1) We provide you with access to the Internet in the form of Wi-Fi access for free use on our premises.

(2) The provision of the Wi-Fi connection is subject to our respective technical and operational capabilities. There is no guarantee of a functional connection or specific local coverage.

(3) Furthermore, we do not guarantee that the Wi-Fi connection will be trouble-free or uninterrupted. Nor can we guarantee transmission speeds.

(4) We reserve the right to change, restrict or discontinue access to the Wi-Fi connection without prior notice in the event of necessary technical repairs and maintenance work.

(5) There is no guarantee that certain services can be used via the Wi-Fi connection. In particular, port blocking may be implemented. Internet surfing and sending and receiving emails are generally possible.

3. Access and use

(1) We offer our guest Wi-Fi only for visitors to our campsite. This is not a publicly accessible telecommunications service, but rather an internal Wi-Fi network for site guests.

(2) Use may require your acceptance of these Terms of Use at the beginning of using the Wi-Fi connection. This can usually be done via a registration form or a welcome page that is then accessible when selecting the Wi-Fi connection as the Wi-Fi network on your device.

(3) There is no entitlement to use the Wi-Fi connection. We reserve the right to restrict or terminate access at any time without giving reasons.

4. Your obligations as a user

(1) You are obligated to ensure that any information you provide about yourself when using the Service is truthful.

(2) You are obliged to comply with applicable laws when using our Wi-Fi connection.

(3) Further obligations arising from other provisions of these Terms of Use remain unaffected.

5. Prices

The service is provided free of charge.

6. Availability of services

Since our services are provided free of charge, you have no right to use the Wi-Fi connection. However, we strive to ensure uninterrupted usability.

7. Prohibited actions

As a user, you are prohibited from engaging in any activities while using the Wi-Fi connection that violate applicable law, infringe the rights of third parties, or violate the principles of child protection. In particular, the following activities are prohibited:

- the posting, distribution, offering and advertising of pornographic, youth protection, data protection and/or other law-violating and/or fraudulent content, services and/or products;
- the publication or making available of content that insults or defames other participants or third parties;
- the use, provision and distribution of content, services and/or products that are protected by law or subject to third-party rights (e.g. copyrights) without being expressly authorized to do so;
- making copyrighted works publicly available or other copyright-infringing activities, particularly when using so-called "Internet file-sharing platforms" or file-sharing services.

Furthermore, regardless of any possible violation of the law, the following activities are prohibited when posting your own content on the service provider's website and when communicating with other users (e.g. by sending personal messages, participating in discussion forums, etc.):

- the transmission of disproportionately large amounts of data and, in particular, the sustained transmission of such amounts of data;
- hosting a web server or other servers using a hotspot of the service provider;
- changing the default DNS servers in the network settings of the service provider's Wi-Fi connection;
- sending junk or spam mail or chain letters;
- the distribution of viruses, Trojans and other malicious files;
- the dissemination of suggestive, offensive, sexually charged, obscene or defamatory content or communication as well as content or communication that is likely to promote or support racism, fanaticism, hatred, physical violence or unlawful acts (in each case explicitly or implicitly);
- requesting other users or third parties to disclose passwords or personal data for commercial or illegal purposes.

Any action that could impair the smooth operation of our Wi-Fi connection, in particular by placing a disproportionate load on our systems, is also prohibited.

8. Blocking access

We may temporarily or permanently block your access to the Wi-Fi connection at any time if there is concrete evidence that these Terms of Use and/or applicable law are being or have been violated, or if we have another legitimate interest in blocking your access.

9. Indemnity

(1) As a user, you are solely responsible for all actions you take in connection with the use of the Internet via our Wi-Fi connection.

(2) You shall indemnify us against all claims asserted against us by third parties due to a violation by the user of statutory provisions, of third-party rights (in particular personal rights, copyrights and trademark rights) or of contractual obligations, representations or guarantees, including the costs of necessary legal defense (attorney and court costs at the statutory rate) upon first request.

(3) In the event of claims being asserted within the meaning of Section 10, Paragraph 2, you are obliged to cooperate promptly and fully in clarifying the facts and to provide us with the information required for this purpose in an appropriate manner.

10. Limitation of liability

- (1) We shall be liable without limitation for all damages caused by us in the event of intent or gross negligence.
- (2) In the event of slight negligence, we shall be liable without limitation in the event of injury to life, body or health.
- (3) Otherwise, we shall only be liable if we have breached a material contractual obligation. Material contractual obligations are defined abstractly as those obligations whose fulfillment is essential for the proper execution of the contract and on whose compliance the user may regularly rely. In these cases, liability is limited to compensation for foreseeable, typically occurring damages.
- (4) To the extent that our liability is excluded or limited under the aforementioned provisions, this shall also apply to our vicarious agents.
- (5) Liability under the Product Liability Act remains unaffected.

11. Data protection

- (1) We ensure that your personal data is only collected, stored and processed to the extent necessary for the contractual provision of services and permitted by statutory provisions or ordered by the legislator.
- (2) In the event that declarations of consent under data protection law are obtained from you as part of the use of our services, we would like to point out that you can revoke these declarations of consent at any time with effect for the future.
- (3) In order to provide the Wi-Fi connection services, the use of personal data from your device may be necessary. In this context, the MAC addresses of your device may also be temporarily stored. Furthermore, we may store log files on the type and extent of service use for 7 days. This data cannot be directly linked to you.

12. Final provisions

- (1) The law of the Federal Republic of Germany shall apply, excluding the application of the UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods.
- (2) If you are a merchant, a legal entity under public law or a special fund under public law, our registered office shall be the exclusive place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from the contractual relationship.
- (3) Should individual provisions of these Terms of Use be or become invalid, this shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

21. Damage and theft

1. Please report any damage or theft to us so the campsite management can take corrective action. This will also help us investigate and repair the damage.
2. If you, your children, or visitors have damaged or destroyed objects or property belonging to other guests or the campsite, it's important to communicate openly. This is especially true if the health of others could be at risk. In many cases, liability insurance covers the damage. Failure to admit damage often means risks, hassle, and costs. These also negatively impact prices.

22. Ban from the premises and place prohibition

1. If a guest intentionally or through gross negligence violates the rules, he or she may be immediately denied further stay in accordance with house rules.
2. In such a case, the campsite "B Camping" retains its right to the agreed total price as lump sum compensation. Refunds of payments already made are excluded.
3. The orders and instructions of the campsite staff, in particular regarding the positioning of motor vehicles, caravans, mobile homes and other vehicles as well as tents or similar structures, must be followed without restriction and immediately.
4. If the instructions of the campsite staff are not followed, the police will be called in for criminal offenses. In the case of offenses that require criminal prosecution, the right to file criminal charges remains reserved.

23. Liability, data protection and contractual issues

These topics are regulated in the General Terms and Conditions (GTC) that you have accepted.

24. General provisions

With the publication of these regulations, all previous regulations lose their validity.

Any invalidity of one or more of the above provisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. Please also note any other posted regulations.
